I would like to take the opportunity to clarify my position on 'extreme' hairstyles. I am very proud of how smart our students present themselves, both in College and on the way to/from home. Indeed, it is something often commended by visitors to our College.

As you are no doubt aware, the College Uniform Policy states that hairstyles should be moderate, with no extremes in style or length. For the avoidance of doubt, hair cut to a length below grade two, or with a significant variation in length across the head (i.e. a significant 'step' or 'undercut') is unacceptable.

If a student chooses to wear their hair in an extreme style they will, in the first instance, be placed in the Student Inclusion Unit for one day, with a letter of warning sent home. If the student chooses to wear their hair in an extreme style on multiple occasions, their time spent in the Student Inclusion Unit will be extended.
