Charity Awareness Reachout Event (CARE) Day: Friday 20th October 2017

As part of Crookhorn's continuing partnership with our four House charities we have arranged a 'Charity Awareness Reachout Event' day, to be held here in College on Friday 20th October 2017 for Year 8. Each of the four Houses at the College support a charity: Help For Heroes, Naomi House, Jack's Place, Hannah's Holiday Home Appeal and The Rainbow Centre. The PE department will also be running a session to raise awareness of the challenges faced and overcome by disabled athletes.

Our intention is that a series of activities, run in partnership with representatives from the charities, will;
