## Hampshire Futures Privacy Notice- 2017

Dear Parents

As the end of the academic year approaches, Hampshire Schools are working closely with Hampshire County Council's Education Participation Team, Hampshire Futures, assisting year 11 pupils until they turn 18.

Hampshire County Council is responsible for coordinating Youth Support Services across Hampshire, helping young people meet their duty to remain in education or training until they are 18 (RPA), as set out in the Education and Skills Act (2008).

To achieve this, Hampshire County Council is required to record information about each young person who goes to school in Hampshire and pass it on to the government each month. The law allows a young person's school or college to share much of the information required, while additional helpful information requires a young person's/ parent's consent (where the young person has not turned 16).

Hampshire County Council may also contact a young person once they have left school, to check if they need support and ensure information held by the County Council is accurate and up-to-date. This is done by telephone, email and text.

To support both young people's and service development within Hampshire the HCC Education Participation/ Careers Services may share information relating to a young person's post-16 education/ training destination with a current or future school/ college or training provider.

All personal and sensitive information held by Hampshire County Council is done so safely and securely and in line with the Data Protection Act(1998) . Any personal or sensitive information held by Hampshire County Council will be deleted after the period of time the Council is allowed to retain this information.

**If you have any queries with regard to the information held, or would like to request information not to be shared on any combination of the following:**

- You would prefer not to be contacted by phone, text or email by Hampshire County Council.
- After year 11 you would prefer Hampshire County Council not to share the young person's future destination information with their current school;
- After year 11 you would prefer Hampshire County Council not to share the young person's future destination information with any future school sixth form/ college or training.
